## ORDINANCE NO. 84- 16

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE BREVARD COUNTY HOUSING FINANCE AUTHORITY; LIMITING THE ABILITY OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA TO APPROVE OR ALTER THE AUTHORITY'S ACTIVITIES; AMENDING SECTIONS 1-180 AND 1-181, BREVARD COUNTY CODE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 1-180, Brevard County Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1-180. Powers of County Commissioners: The County may, at in its sole discretion, and at any time, alter or-change-the-structure;-organization;-programs-or-activities of-the-Authority;-including-the-power-to terminate the Authority, subject to any limitation on the impairment of contracts entered into by the Authority and subject to the limitations or requirements of the Act.

SECTION 2. Section 1-181, Brevard County Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1-181. Approval of County Commission: The following actions of the Authority shall first be approved by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Brevard County, Florida as a prior condition to such actions becoming effective:

(a)--Any-rules-or-regulations-to-be-promulgated-by
the-Authority-setting-forth-standards-or-criteria-for-determining
"eligible-persons"-or-"qualifying-housing-development"-

(b)--Any-resolution-authorizing-the-issuance-of-revenue bonds-as-authorized-in-the-Act-

(c)--Ail-contracts-or-agreements-of-the-Authority(d)--Any-sale-of-bonds,-whether-by-publis-or-private
sale,-authorized-in-the-Act.

te}--Any-other-action-in-which-the-Board-of-County

(a) Any resolution, agreement or other action required by state or federal law to be approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

SECTION 3. Severability: If any section, subparagraph, sentence, clause or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion hereof.

SECTION 4. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
