

ORDINANCE NO. 84- 16

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE BREVARD COUNTY HOUSING FINANCE AUTHORITY; LIMITING THE ABILITY OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA TO APPROVE OR ALTER THE AUTHORITY'S ACTIVITIES; AMENDING SECTIONS 1-180 AND 1-181, BREVARD COUNTY CODE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Section 1-180, Brevard County Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1-180. Powers of County Commissioners: The County may, ~~at~~ in its sole discretion, and at any time, ~~alter or change the structure, organization, programs or activities of the Authority, including the power to~~ terminate the Authority, subject to any limitation on the impairment of contracts entered into by the Authority and subject to the limitations or requirements of the Act.

SECTION 2. Section 1-181, Brevard County Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1-181. Approval of County Commission: The following actions of the Authority shall first be approved by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Brevard County, Florida as a prior condition to such actions becoming effective:

~~(a)---Any rules or regulations to be promulgated by the Authority setting forth standards or criteria for determining "eligible persons" or "qualifying housing development".~~

~~(b)---Any resolution authorizing the issuance of revenue bonds as authorized in the Act.~~

~~(c)---All contracts or agreements of the Authority.~~

~~(d)---Any sale of bonds, whether by public or private sale, authorized in the Act.~~

~~(e)---Any other action in which the Board of County~~

~~Commissioners of Brevard County, Florida has by resolution

(a) Any resolution, agreement or other action  
required by state or federal law to be approved by the Board

SECTION 3. Severability: If any section, subparagraph,  
sentence, clause or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason  
held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent  
jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct  
and independent provision and such holding shall not affect  
the validity of the remaining portion hereof.

SECTION 4. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall take  
effect immediately upon its adoption.
